

KC PAGA Tournament Rules

General Rules

1. In order to compete in club tournaments, all members dues must be paid in full by the due date set by the Executive Committee. Members not paid or in good standing will be subject to disqualification at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
2. All tournaments will be played under the rules of the United States Golf Association (U.S.G.A.) except where local rules apply. The ball shall be played up or down, according to the rules of the course being played or at the discretion of the tournament chairman. Disputes over the rules shall be settled in the club house by the Executive Committee.
3. Players need to check in 30 minutes prior to tournament play. Late golfers will be placed back in the rotation at discretion of the tournament chairman or club officer. Golfers who do not call in on the league information line will be placed at the back of the rotation if space is available.
4. The tournament chairman will make all pairings.
5. Call-in Deadline for All Tournaments is 5:00 P.M. on the Friday before the tournament. Call 816-881-1190 and leave clear message with your name and phone number. Deadline for cancellation will be 5:00 P.M. on the Friday before the tournament. Members who do not cancel by this time will be responsible for his or her green fee. Members will not be allowed to play any tournaments until the outstanding fees are paid.
6. No player or players shall complete a hole or practice on the course prior to the start of the set tournament time. Practice is restricted to the course practice area only.

Club Handicaps

1. Club handicaps will be maintained via the MiniMax Golf Handicapping service. Tournament scores will be submitted to MiniMax by the Handicap Chairman.
2. Score cards must be turned into the handicap chairman at the end of each tournament. If the handicap chairman is not available score cards will be collected by a club officer.
3. Scorecards must be legible, totaled, and signed. First and last name must be on all score cards turned in to the handicap chairman. Cards must also indicate which tee was played by each golfer. The handicap chairman reserves the right to refuse any card that does not meet these guidelines.
4. Handicaps for new members will be generated after three rounds of tournament play.
5. National PAGA events will count as club tournament play. Players will be responsible for turning in National PAGA score cards to the handicap chairman. Cards must follow the guidelines set forth in rule #3.

KC PAGA Tournament Rules

Club Championship

1. Any member that has not played in at least 7 club tournaments will not be eligible for the Club Championship.
2. During handicap stroke play all ties shall be determined by the following methods (recommended by the U.S.G.A.)
 - a. The Winner shall be determined by matching scorecards for the last nine holes using $\frac{1}{2}$ of their handicap.
 - b. If the tying players have same score by the last 6 holes, the last three holes, and finally the 18th hole using $\frac{1}{3}^{\text{rd}}$, $\frac{1}{6}^{\text{th}}$, etc of the players handicap to determine the winner.
3. There will be no pre-play or make up rounds for the club championship.
4. Rules violations must be brought to the attention of the tournament chairman or the Executive Committee and settled prior to awarding of tournament prizes. No ruling shall be overturned thereafter.
